Internet Use Agreement

I, the undersigned, have read and understand the Library Internet Use Policy (KPLP-12) that states, in part:

“The Library is governed by the Children’s Internet Protection Act. Its public access computers contain software that prohibits access to inappropriate sites, however, the same software also prohibits users from accessing personal information – bank accounts, email, job applications, etc. Any patron seventeen or above may request the filter be removed during their session. Removing the filter **does not** grant the patron permission to access inappropriate sites. Patrons who continue to misuse public computers will have future access denied.”

I understand that continued misuse of Internet resources, including the viewing of inappropriate material (hereby defined as obscene, pornographic, or otherwise objectionable) will be grounds for suspension of Library access. I also understand that all decisions concerning objectionable materials are the responsibility of the Director of the Library. I may appeal such decision/suspension to the Kingston Public Library Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting. The Board’s decision is final.
